During the month of April, the bay has experienced an historically abnormal amount of Sea Lion presence in the North Bay area. For the last few weeks of the month, they have inundated the pier area with no access for boats to moor. No incidents to report due to the Sea Lion traffic. Yet the dock is starting to sustain some damage due to their presence.

Upon arriving at Allyn Waterfront for nightly gate closure, a 2000's White Chevrolet Silverado Truck License WA# B75840T was stuck in Berry Betzinger's yard. Berry was outside with the driver. The driver smelled strongly of alcohol and appeared intoxicated. I quietly reminded Berry that it would not be wise at this point to help him get unstuck. We agreed that I would slip away and notify law enforcement. While making the call to Mason County Sheriff the driver spoke to Berry about being worried about being deported for his immigration status. He fled the area on foot before Mason County Sheriff arrived. Once Mason County Sheriff arrived, I relayed my observations and left the scene of the incident. They said they would look around town for the driver and call a tow truck for the impounding of the vehicle.
